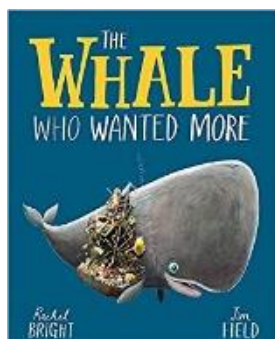




## YEAR 1 & 2
